FAQ:

☼ Do I have to take the Praxis II test in Sped to add my mild/moderate disability (SPED) endorsement?

NO. The completion of the 4 SPED courses in your degree program qualify you for the add-on in mild/moderate disabilities by means of an "approved program".

- **How can I certify for** <u>middle school grades or above</u> **and be highly qualified?** Middle School grades are identified as grades 7 & 8. You may add secondary endorsements (grades 7-8 or 7-12) by coursework **OR** Praxis in a specialty area (i.e. English, Social Studies, etc.) to add higher level grades.
- How can my concentrations be used towards endorsements? MDE will accept a total of two (2) methods courses linked to your two concentrations for add-on endorsements. The methodology course does not count as part of the required 18 hours; it is added to the completed 18 for endorsement purposes only. You must have a letter grade of "C" or higher in all 21 hours to add the endorsement. *Accepted professional methodology courses include: EDEL 401; EDEL 402; EDEL 403; and EDEL 404.

[Note: Beginning September 2014 changes were made to the requirements for the *mathematics* add-on through coursework – varying grades 7-8 or 7-12].
