What is TeachLive?

- TeachLive is a **virtual classroom experience** where you have the opportunity to teach a short lesson (Don't worry! We've already created the lesson plans for you.)
- In the TeachLive room, you will find a large TV screen where the avatar students will come to life! They will act just like "real" students by asking you questions and occasionally disrupting class.



Fall 2023 Expectations

- You are required to complete your first TeachLive session this semester
- You will be teaching a lesson already provided for you
- The lesson should take approximately **10-12 minutes** to teach
- Please **dress professionally** like you would for your field placement
- You must complete your session in order to **pass** the EDCI 352 course
- Failure to complete your session will result in a **disposition** infraction
- You will complete a DocuSign form stating you agree to the expectations. Please make sure you read and sign the form as soon as possible. This will be sent to your @go email account.



How do you schedule your session?

- You will receive an email from “No-reply” welcoming you to Mursion. Mursion is the platform that we use for TeachLive. *Please make sure to check your spam folder if you don't receive it!*
- Your email will look like the image to the right →
- Click on the “**Visit your Dashboard to Get Started**” button



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How do you schedule your session?

- Next, you will be prompted to create a password. Your **password will be specific for the Mursion Portal** and is in no way affiliated with your MyOleMiss password. You will use this password again for future courses.
- After you create a password, you will have to agree to Mursion's code of conduct →
- Check the box and hit "accept"

Methodology Overview & Code of Conduct

Every Mursion simulation involves a single live Simulation Specialist who provides the spoken dialogue for up to five virtual avatars in a learning session. The Simulation Specialist's job is to present conversational challenges to enable Learners, such as yourself, to practice the complex human skills in each scenario. At Mursion we recognize the importance of creating a safe space where people can bravely practice potentially stressful, nuanced, and complex conversations. To ensure that both Learners and the Simulation Specialist can participate confidently, we ask individuals in both groups to commit to a basic Code of Conduct.

- Your @go email account will already be listed

- You will also be asked to confirm your time zone
- It is already set to “CDT,” so you will just click

Where can you find your video recording?
