The WCTP Offers Two Types of Mentoring


- Face-to-Face at the following locations: Southaven, Oxford, Tupelo, and Grenada
- Online, available any where in Mississippi



What Does Mentoring Look Like

- · All candidates are provided a National Board Certified Teacher
- Face-to-Face meets twice a month for two hours. Mentors will provide schedules
- Mentoring starts in the second week in September, but candidates may join at any time
- Online Candidates will use WCTP 601, a Blackboard course, as their curriculum. Candidates
 work through a module for each component and submit specific assignments to their mentor
 via email. Zoom meetings are also available for online candidates, which allows you to meet
 face-to-face online
- Mentors provide guidance and direction
- Mentors read for their candidates

WCTP 601 is made available to ALL our candidates. This is a Blackboard candidate support course that is step-by-step and self-paced. This course was created in collaboration with Stanford University.
