IDENTIFY NEEDS

Reflect on your practice to determine a professional learning need and student need that requires advocacy and collaboration. Needs must be clearly connected to student learning and your practice.

ASSESS

Identify goals (objectives) from the data collected from your group profile. Lead your students through the assessment cycle paying close attention to use of formative assessment to realign and or adjust your goals/objectives as needed for the need of your students.
